


The 2012 season saw 11 children play Minkey Hockey with 8 of them having their first season of Hockey.

Libby, Kaylen and Jazz were the babies of the team, all still being able to play under 7's, not taking a backward step from their older opponents.


Liam and Jack were our developing players who had a consistent season playing, who showed some fine skills both at training and in the games.

#### Under 13 Red Coaches Report

The team had a fantastic season winning both the major and minor under 13 premierships. During the 13 round games the team scored 106 goals the highest of any team in any age division, to complement this we also had the equal best defensive record of any team in any age division conceding just 2 goals scored by the West's Blue team in the 1<sup>st</sup> match of the season. During the round games only West's Illawarra Blue (3-2) and Albion Park White (1-0) provided us with difficult matches on our way to claiming the minor premiership undefeated.

The success of this year has been a work in progress for many years with this year building on the basic skills taught in previous years combined with developing a style of play that saw us moving the ball around quickly with multiple passes involving multiple players. The transition from individual skills to a team based game is the reason for our success this year along with the individual improvement in every one of our players who all worked very hard at training. In the semi final Albion Park White reversed the round game result defeating us 1-0. A win against Flames in the final saw a rematch against Albion Park White for the grand final. A goal to Kelsey Hughes in the 1<sup>st</sup> half gave us the lead before Albion Park equalised in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half to send the match into extra time. Knowing a draw would be enough to secure the premiership did not stop the team from putting in a totally dominant display in extra time that resulted in many close misses and no opportunities for our opposition. The match finished 1-1 securing West's their 1<sup>st</sup> U13 premiership since 1994.

At a representative level Hayden, Jackson & Josh were selected in the Illawarra Boys U13 A team, Adam & Luke the Illawarra Boys U13 B team, Chloe, Kelsey, Rachel and Zoe the Illawarra Girls U13 A team. Chloe went on to be selected in the NSW U13 Development Team.

To my manager Katrina Davies thank you for organising all of the match day responsibilities. Finally a thank you to all the players and parents for your help in getting kids to training and matches and the support you have given them throughout the year.

U15 Blue 2012 Report

Another good season with this team this year. I have coached some of them since they were 8 years old and most for the past 4 years and they are a good bunch of kids.

The Blues are all full age Under 15 players and expectations were high after our season 2 years ago in the U13s. We finished equal first on points, but 2<sup>nd</sup> on goal differences during the normal season, with the only loss to Albion Park, who we rebounded to beat later in the season. This year I have decided to award the Coaches Award to Mitch Galea for his outstanding commitment to his hockey and team. Mitch ran the middle of the field for us and dominated opposition players. He was always at training and missed 1 game throughout the season through illness, which was hard for him to do. He even played injured when most would not have. Well Done Mitch on a career changing year and look forward to watching you in the coming years.

I have also given an Outstanding Achievement Award to Thomas Miotto. Thomas not only scored 21 goals for the season, which I believe was the highest for the U15 comp, his control of our right side attack resulted in many of our teams 70 goals. Thomas was also selected in the U15 NSW Development team that will play games against Queensland and attend coaching sessions in Ballina. An Outstanding Achievement for him. Well done Thomas

I must mention how well our back 3 played this year in defense. Only 1 goal in 10 of our normal season games, shows what a great ability they had to keep teams at bay. Daniel in goals has developed into a competent grade keeper as well, Chloe is playing first grade hockey with the women's and Rhys was solid all year with good tackling techniques now developed and distribution improving.



Next year the kids will need to make the difficult decision on whether to move onto U17s and also senior grade hockey if not already playing. I have done what I can for their development and hope that we can source a coach for these kids that can take them to the next level. A coach with extensive knowledge of the game and skills needed at a higher level. Many future 1st grade players will come out of this team and this is the time to develop the right skills.

Lastly thanks to the parents who have given the kids massive support this year. I will miss the yelling from the sideline in support of the kids.
